

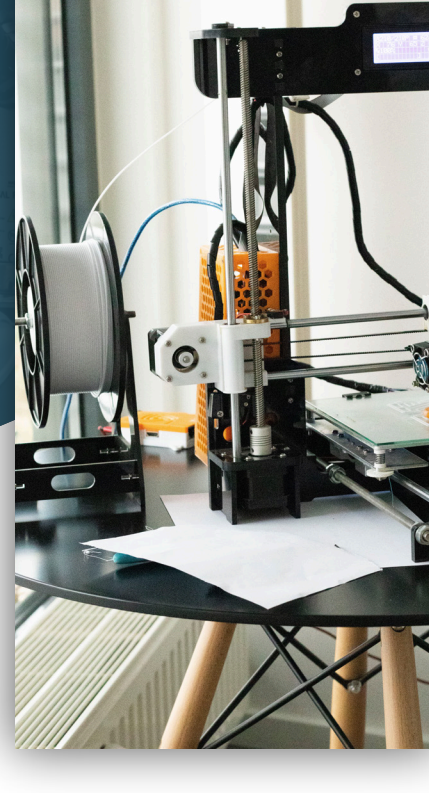

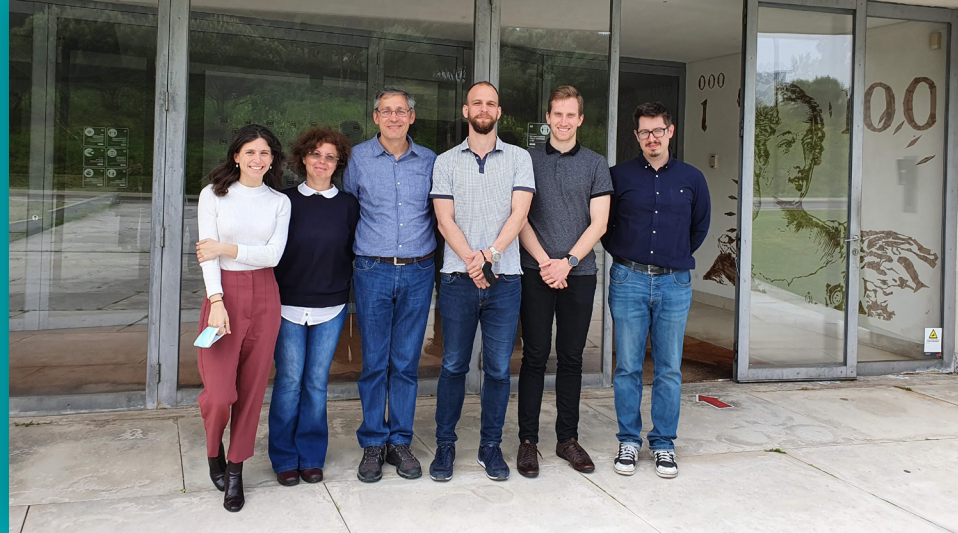

Closing the year, EAGLE project partners have been together in Iasi - Romania for the 3rd project meeting. The status of each milestone and outputs of EAGLE Project..

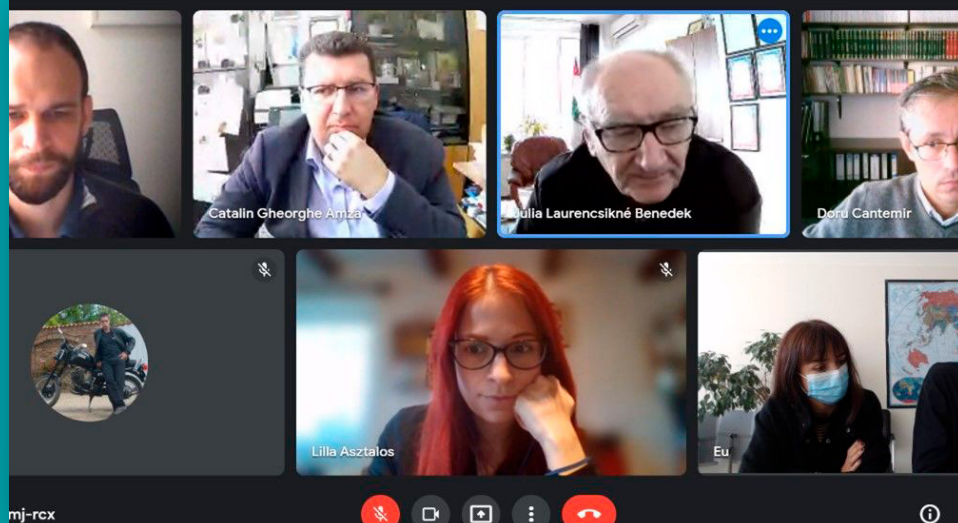
